1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Central Coast Junior Motorcycle Club INC, hereafter called the Promoter will conduct 2021 NSW Junior U/16 125cc Solo Speedway Championship for U/16 125cc Solo at the Central Coast Junior Motorcycle Club Inc, Debenham Road North Somersby, on Saturday 5th February 2022.

1.1 Supplementary Rain off schedule: If the meeting has been postponed for the reason of force majeure the date will be Sunday 6th February 2022. If the rain date cannot be run in its entirety, but the meeting has reached 75% for all competitors, then a result may be declared by the steward based on the points at the time of the determination. If it has not reached 75%, then the event will be declared null and void and further decisions of status of this event are at the discretion of Motorcycling Australia.

2. JURISDICTION

2.1 The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling NSW which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number [Insert Permit Number] and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Competition Licenses.

2.2 The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCRs) contained in the Manual of Motorcycle Sport, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by MNSW. By entering this meeting all parties agree to comply with these rules, regulations, by-laws, and instructions.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Entries are now open and close via email Friday 21st January 2022 5pm Late entries will not be accepted.

4.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Central Coast Junior Motorcycle Club Inc, if such retention is approved by MNSW.

4.3 Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

4.4 Entry fees will only be refunded if a rider informs Central Coast Junior Motorcycle Club Inc, in writing, 10 days before the event. A medical certificate is required if a rider withdraws less than 10 days before the event.

5. ENTRY FEE

5.1 Junior Solo: \$95 Junior - 250cc Sidecar support \$95– 50cc Demo support \$60

5.3 Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the Central Coast Junior Motorcycle Club Inc.

6. ENTRY PASSES

No passes required.

7. INSURANCE

7.1 National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

7.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

It is strongly recommended that competitors give consideration to taking out weekly benefits insurance.

8. MEDICAL SERVICES

St John medical services shall be in attendance at the meeting from 9.30am to conclusion of the meeting.

[Note to Promoters: Australian Championships require civil ambulances to be in attendance at all times ie, ambulance to transport injured to hospital]

9. SCRUTINEERING

9.1 Scrutineering will begin at 9am.

9.2 Machines entered in the competition must have successfully passed a machine examination prior to taking part in practice, qualifying or racing. An MA decal will be placed on the front number plate to indicate that it has been successfully examined.

9.3 Current competition licences and full riding gear must be presented at scrutineering. Eligibility checks can take place at any time during the meeting. Machines which suffer accident damage in practice or race sessions must be re-examined before participating again.

9.4 In addition to supervising the pulling down and checking of machines after official protests have been received by the Clerk of Course in accordance with the GCRs, the Steward can order that any machine be measured and if this occurs the Scrutineer will supervise a team member to pull down any machine that has taken part in the event. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.

9.5 Machines will not be sealed for later checking after the event. All machines that are to be pulled down and scrutineered will take place at the circuit before the machine is released by the Scrutineer. A member of the rider's team must be available at all times to carry out the strip down under the control of the Scrutineer. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in this matter being referred to the Clerk of Course for further action.

10. CLASSES OF COMPETITION

2021 NSW Open U/16 125cc Speedway Solo Championships Open to the holder of a current MA National competition license endorsed for speedway.
Support 250cc Junior Speedway Sidecars & 50cc Demo.

11. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS

11.1 To constitute a class for the purpose of gaining Championship status, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be at least 16 entries or more.

11.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and/or prizemoney, will be at the discretion of the Central Coast Junior Motorcycle Club Inc, subject to MNSW approval.

12. STARTS AND FINISHES

Starts will be done by speedway tapes and green lights as per GCR's.
Finish is checkered flag.
Practice Starts are not permitted at the main starting area.

13. FLAGS AND SIGNALS

Green light, Yellow flag with diagonal black line last lap flag & checker flag.

14. RACE FORMAT

Where there are 16 Riders there will be 5 Rounds, with each heat of 4 laps.

14.1 20 Heats, 1 A Final, 1 B Final.

14.2 The B Final is made up of the 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th placed competitors after the 20 Heats. The winner of the B Final will go to the A Final, place getters 2nd, 3rd 4th will be placed 5th, 6th & 7th in this Championship.

14.3 The A Final is made up of the top 3 placed competitors who accumulated the most points in the 20 Heats, and the winner of the B Final.

14.4 Gate picks for A & B Finals will be by points scored after 20 Heats.

14.4 Starting positions will be offered to the riders in descending order of points accumulated in the heats, riders on tied points gate choice will be determined by count back where 0 is better than M, R, F, T and N.

14.5 Scoring as per GCR's 1st = 3 points 2nd = 2 points 3rd = 1 point 4th = 0 points

14.6 Results will remain "Provisional" until ratified and confirmed by MNSW.

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 9am with the completion of the meeting for the participant being when the participant has vacated the venue.

16. AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY

Trophies for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place getters in championship classes, MNSW Medallions will be presented to the first 3 place getters.

17. PAYG

PAYG Withholding affects the payment of prizemoney. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 46.5% of prizemoney over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

18. PRESENTATIONS

Presentation shall be conducted at the completion of the program infield of the Track.

19. MACHINES AND RIDERS

19.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Speedway competition.

19.2 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.

19.3 Change of machine is allowed as long as the clerk of the course has been notified about the change prior to the event and the bike has been scrutineered.

20. RIDING NUMBERS

MNSW Speedway Committee will allocate Rider Numbers for the Championship Event.

All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCRs and must not contain any decals or advertising other than the required MA decal.

21. GRID POSITIONS

Heats will be pre-drawn by the MNSW Speedway Committee and listed in the program for all heats. Riders Choice for grid positions In the A AND B FINALS as per GCRs.

22. RIDERS' BRIEFING

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, All competitors, parents/guardians must attend Rider Briefing. Details will be included in the final instructions.

23. CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION

114 meters in length construction of rilit anti clock wise direction.

24. TRACK INSPECTION

All competitors will be given the opportunity to walk and inspect the track prior to any on track participation. This inspection must be done on foot and competitors are reminded that service vehicles may be in operation on the circuit at this time.

24.1 Track Dissatisfaction

Competitors who are not satisfied with any aspects of the track can present these concerns to the Clerk of Course if those concerns cannot be resolved, the competitor will be invited to withdraw from the meeting.

25. FACILITIES

Canteen and Toilets will be available.

26. NOISE

All machines must comply with the requirements of the GCR's and track licence. Noise testing may take place at any time at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer or the Clerk of Course.

27. TYRES

As Per GCR's

28. ANTI-DOPING POLICY

28.1 All competitors, crew, parents / guardians and officials are advised that drug testing may take place in accordance with MA's Anti-Doping Policy, under the authority of Sport Integrity Australia.

28.2 Athletes are advised to download the Sports Integrity Australia app. If athletes have any doubts over Sports Integrity Australia requirements they should visit the website www.sportintegrity.gov.au

It is recommended athletes contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline (1300 027 232) for further information. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prize money may be delayed, at the discretion of MA, until the results of the tests are known.

29. DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING

All competitors and officials are advised that random drug and alcohol testing may take place during the competition. Refer to MA website for details on the Safety Policy – Drug and Alcohol testing.

30. CODES OF BEHAVIOUR

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of MA's Codes of Behavior contained within MA's Member Protection Regulations, found at www.ma.org.au which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. These Codes of Behavior apply to this meeting and will be enforced.

31. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

All riders must have a minimum 2kg, dry powder A:B (E) class, working fire extinguisher in their pit area

32. ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS AND SOCIAL MEDIA

All competitors, officials and parents are bound by of MA's Social Media Policy, found at www.ma.org.au, which sets out a framework for acceptable online behavior where communications involve fellow MA members, volunteers, officials, coaches, sponsors, partners, staff and any other connected persons, penalties may apply for breaches of the policy.

33. ADMISSION CHARGES

No Cost of entry to the venue.

34. ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

All teams and riders are responsible for the removal of all items including rubbish from their pit area as they vacate the premises. Penalties may apply as per GCR 6.1.1.1 a)

Used tyres cannot be left on site. Any rider found to have left tyres in the pit area will be fined for the cost of their disposal.
