Action Items for attention before Central Coast Cup

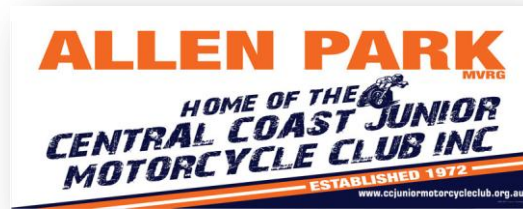
- Committee to chase up applicable type of dirt for the track for the Central Coast Cup this week some time and try to establish how much clay is in the product. We will also require two loads of rocks for the pit area, and if other grader is coming, this also includes repairing the driveway area too.
- If Council are available to come to the track on the 11/5/19 we will hold a 'working bee' –

Jobs for actioning and tools required at the working bee-

- Generator 3-4 kv, compressor and paint to paint the wall
- finish placing chairs in after concrete is poured in to holes
- check PA
- gurney and petrol
- complete placing the Coates barriers into position
- repair fence and clean drain on turn 4
- engine oil and diesel fuel required
- Grader battery (Col)
- block off area from the green shed onwards, using the large barriers, to block access to riders riding over to the back area of the track
- Define track area at the 'dog leg', push away from corner 3, define turn 3 & 4, possibility of laying turf around the 'dog leg'

Other Items for Actioning

- Send card to Ryan Smith – Emma
- Send emails out to local businesses in the attempt to obtain sponsorships for the Central Coast Cup – Emma
- Dave to chase up the timers
- Weld windows and doors in canteen
- Speedway drains relocated and cleaned out
